

# *Weston Run – Historic Results*

The Data Protection General Regulation (GDPR), which came into force in 2018, is designed to protect individuals' rights about personal data. The organisers of the Weston Run take this responsibility very seriously and wish to comply fully with the legal and moral obligations of the new code.

Publication of results containing information that could identify individuals might be interpreted as a breach of privacy, so we have replaced our historic results with this notice. This is designed to give previous runners peace of mind and maximum protection under the new regulations.

In future years our registration process will inform applicants about the details that will be published on our web site and ask in advance for their consent to include them in the results listings. If a runner decides not to give this consent, their name will be blanked out in the published results.
